Notice Inviting Tender

India Taipei Association, Taipei (ITA) invites sealed bids from experienced contractors for construction work at the new venue of ITA & dismantling of the present venue of ITA in TWTC, ITB, No. 333, Keelung Road, Sec.1, Taipei, Taiwan.

2. The total time period for the construction and dismantling work will be 40 days.
3. Contractors who fulfil the following criteria shall be eligible to apply: [These criteria are indicative. Exact details are available in tender documents.]
 - i. The bidder should have valid permit/registration from a competent local authority for carrying out construction & dismantling works in ITA.
 - ii. The bidder should not have suffered a loss in more than two years during the last five financial years.
 - iii. The bidder should have a certificate of solvency for 40% of the value of the estimated bid certified by banker, not older than six months.
 - iv. The annual turnover of the bidder during the immediate last three consecutive financial years should be greater than or equal to the bid amount.
 - v. The bidder should have satisfactorily completed
 - (a) one similar work of 80% value of cost estimates or
 - (b) two similar works of 60% value of cost estimates or
 - (c) three similar works of 40% value of cost estimates.

Similar works mean construction of similar work for foreign offices in TWTC ITB/Taipei diplomatic buildings/buildings of international importance, office buildings, hotels, shopping malls, apartment complex etc.

4. Earnest Money Deposit: Along with the bid, the bidder must submit the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of NTD 250,000. EMD shall be acceptable as demand draft or banker's cheque or bank guarantee. The other terms and conditions related with EMD shall remain same as mentioned in the tender document. EMD shall remain valid for a period of One Hundred Eighty (180) days from last date of submission of tender. Any tender received without EMD will be summarily rejected.

Mattam, Deputy Director General, Suites 2010-2012, TWTC, ITB, No. 333, Keelung Road, Sec.1, Taipei, Taiwan.

8. If any information furnished by the applicant is found incorrect at a later stage, he/she shall be liable to be debarred from the tendering process. ITA reserves its right to verify the particulars furnished by the applicant independently.

9. ITA reserves the right to reject any prospective applicant without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of pre-qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it.
